Euchee Restaurant under New Management

The popular Monkey Town Brewing Company of Dayton has chosen Euchee Marina for their second restaurant location. The grand opening of **Euchee Grill & Brewhouse** is set for Thursday, April 13 at 5:00 pm, with Trivia Night planned for every Thursday at 7:00 pm. They'll be open Thursday-Sunday until the 3rd week in May when summer hours begin. At that point it will be seven days a week for lunch and dinner, and as an added bonus-- breakfast on Saturday & Sunday. After Labor Day they'll go back to Thursday-Sunday hours but will stay open year-round.

The menu will be similar to Monkey Town's, but will have its own twist as a waterfront venue. In the summer there will be quick pick up food down on the dock on Saturday & Sundays. Beer, wine and liquor will be served.
